#### **Vacations:**



#### **Academic Wings**

There is a big campus of 13 acres approx. in which the entire school and hostel infrastructure is located. There are beautiful parks: Just left to the main gate and Rabbit Park beside the big football and basket ball grounds. The Academic Blocks comprise

#### Shishu Vatika [Pre Primary] (Classes Nursery to One)

Tiny tots just play and dance to learn. They avail themselves mother-like care. There are two units of the school, one running at Hasanpur, Rajgir and the other at Gorakshini near Bharaopar in Biharsarif.

#### Shishu Mandir [Primary] (Classes II to V)

Small children do lots of things to learn. They avail themselves stress free education. They are imparted Art & Craft education also.

#### Vidya Mandir [Junior Secondary] (Classes VI to VIII)

Bhaiyas/Bahans build up confidence to stage and expose their potentialities through various co-scholastic activities.

#### Vidya Mandir [Secondary & Senior Secondary] (Classes IX to XII)

Bhaiyas/Bahans undergo major psycho-physiological changes and learn to cope up with them. They learn to know themselves and live a life useful for the society.

#### Vidya Mandir [Senior Secondary] (Classes XI to XII)

Bhaiyas/Bahans learn to shape career through science. Theory & Practical Classes run from Monday to Saturday

#### **Book List & Syllabus**

The book list is given at the time of admission and just after annual exam is over every year. The syllabus is given by the end of April.

#### Attendance:

> 75% attendance is essential for promotion to next class.

It is compulsory for a Bhaiya/Bahan to attend the school on the day before long vacation and on the day the school opens after the vacation.

No leave is granted if it is not sought earlier through an application by Parents.

#### **Expulsion:**

A Bhaiya/Bahan may be debarred from the class if he / she does not follow the school rules.

Irregular attendance / habitual idleness / disobedience / lack of cooperation / evidence of misconduct / evidence of damaging the school property is sufficient reason for expulsion / dismissal from the school.



#### **School Transport System:**

- School provides vehicle facilities to the extent of its capacity.
- A Bhaiya/Bahan should board the vehicle designated for him / her.
- He / she should not get down any other vehicle stop without permission of the Principal and Vehicle In Charge.
- Parents availing themselves of should arrange to see the children off to the vehicle stop and also receive them.
- All the Bhaiyas/Bahans availing vehicle facility must reach the stop in time.
- In case the school vehicle does not ply due to unavoidable circumstances, the parents have to bring children to school and take them back by their own means.







The parents in general and Bhaiyas/Bahans, in particular MUST very well understand the rules and strictly abide by them to the desired extent:


- 1. School expects from its Bhaiyas/Bahans to religiously abide by the rules and regulations as furnished from time to time.
- 2. Bhaiyas/Bahans are expected to ever remain obedient and devoted to their Acharyajees (teachers) so as to ensure a very healthy, positive and rewarding academic atmosphere.
- 3. Bhaiyas/Bahans are expected to have a sense of devotion to mother Saraswati, goddess of education and learning; and keep all the stationeries, Text Books, Exercise Books etc. properly.
- 4. Bhaiyas/Bahans are expected to attend school not only in complete & well tailored but also in neat and clean and well pressed School Uniform.
- 5. Bhaiyas/Bahans are expected to regard their school as a Temple of Learning; and hence they must have a high morale of the institution they are reading in.
- 6. No scholar is allowed to keep with himself/herself things like money in cash, watch, calculator, necklace, ring, camera, transistor, video games, cell phones, I-pod etc. Day Scholars who come to school by their own arrangement may have money in cash but as per need.
- 7. No scholar is allowed to bring any kind of electronic storage device inside IT lab.
- 8. Any type of conduct against the institutional character will be treated as serious delinquency and liable to severe punishment.
- 9. School fees must be deposited in time and cleared before the commencement of Summative Assessments.
- 10. Day scholars are expected to come to school in time with their Tiffin Box not full of junk foods but with home made nutritious food stuffs.
- 11. Each and every Bhaiya/Bahan is expected to bring School Diary & Vandana Book daily.
- 12. Bhaiyas/Bahans are expected to talk in good English in a very noble way. When expected to speak in Samskrit, they are expected to the fluent in Sanskrit too.
- 13. Repeated violation of any of the above rules may compel the management to consider the case very deeply and ultimately decide to send a Bhaiya/Bahan back to his/her home.





- We have own separate laboratories for Physics, Chemistry & Biology.

- Competitive examinations for science experiments are performed every year.

#### Lodging

- There are four major blocks of the hostel viz. KESHAV BHAWAN, MADHAV BHAWAN, DEV BHAWAN & MADHUKAR BHAWAN.
- KESHAV BHAWAN is three storied. Boarders of classes IV and V dwell in separate dormitories allotted to them.
- MADHAV BHAWAN & DEV BHAWAN is also three storied. Boarders of classes VI to IX dwell in separate dormitories allotted to them.
- Boarders of class X to XII dwell in separate dormitories of the MADHUKAR BHAWAN.
- Each dormitory contains specially designed cot in sufficient number to avoid congestion and suffocation.
- Wardens are there in each block to supervise the boarders.
- Separate Hostel Superintendents are there to manage each and every thing of the Hostel Blocks.



#### **Accessories**

- A boarder is expected to have with him the things of daily use. A separate list of such things will be given at the time of admission.
- Tailoring, Laundry, Hair Cutting Saloon and Cobbling facilities are also there for the convenience of the boarders.

#### **Time Table**

The hostel follows a well planned daily routine from 05:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. of its own according to which every boarder lives his life.

#### **Food**

- We provide vegetarian meal to our boarders as per scientifically designed Weekly Food Chart.
- We provide RO & UV filtered water.
- Expert and experienced cooks are there with a catering supervisor who checks the quality of food cooked.
- > There is a well furnished dining hall where the boarders have their breakfast, meals or snacks in a peaceful atmosphere.

#### **Tutorial Classes**

- 2 hours tutorial classes run in the evening every day except Sundays and National Festival Days.
- The boarders are made to sit class wise in two separate sections: Section A contains pupils with performance below average. Section B contains pupils with performance above average.
- Remedial coaching is provided to the individual pupils in order to facilitate the learning of difficult points in different subjects.

#### **Medical Facility**

We own a kit of both Allopathic & Homoeopathic medicines that cover common diseases like acute cough, cold, fever, boils, colic, indigestion, headache, and other first aids cases. An experienced registered physician is also there to offer medical assistance in time. In case of clinical investigations and further advice nearby doctors from Rajgir and Biharsharif are consulted and proper nursing is provided accordingly.

#### **Ambulance Facility**

We own a ambulance facility available in school campus for emergency treatment.



#### **Boarders' Bharti**

There is Boarders' own Parliament in each hostel block. It calls planned meetings to administer the various functions related to the hostel. They automatically develop leadership traits and sense of cooperation.

#### **Birthday Celebration**

Pupils celebrate their birthdays as a resolution day for their goal oriented life; they take solemn oath / resolution to become a great personality but for the welfare of their nation i.e Mother India. They take blessings from the teachers & others superior to them on the occasion and enjoy the day.

#### **Games**

- In the evening all the boarders are sent into different playgrounds as per plan to learn varieties of indoor and outdoor games.
- Selected boarders learn martial arts too.

#### **Entertainment**

Each hostel block has its own Television set installed with Tata Sky. Pupils are made to watch News Channels every evening just after the tutorial classes are over. Once in a fortnight a Hindi feature film is shown to the pupils. On One Day Cricket Matches they are permitted to watch the live telecast or the highlights in free time.

#### **Telephonic Contact**

There are 4 mobile phones for the contact purpose. They are exclusively on on Sundays from 07:00 a.m. to 05:30 p.m. Besides, the facility is available on the birthdays too. In unavoidable circumstances the facility is provided by the Hostel Superintendent.

Parents may visit the hostel to meet their child on Sundays or on specified holidays from 09:00 a.m. to 05:00 p.m.

#### **Vacations**

Three long vacations fall in the session: Summer Vacation (35 days) Durga Puja Vacation (7 days); Deepawali-Chhatha Vacation (13 days) during which school remains closed and so the hostel also.

One day session break is given in the end of the session. Permission to leave the hostel is granted in case of special occasions like marriage ceremonies, Yajnopaveet Samskar etc. taking place at their own homes.

#### **HOSTEL RULES**

The parents, in general and boarders, in particular MUST very well understand the rules and strictly abide by them to the desired extent.



- 1. Only parents as mentioned / registered in the hostel records are entitled to meet / phone their child concerned.
- 2. Parents are strictly prohibited from meeting their child in his dormitory.
- 3. No boarder is allowed to keep with himself things like money in cash, watch, calculator, necklace, ring, camera, transistor, video games, cell phones, I-pod or any kind of electronic storage device.
- 4. No parent is permitted to provide any eatables to his / her child. If it is very essential, he / she will have to supply the same to all the boarders and that too through the Hostel Superintendent.
- 5. There is no provision for the parents to stay in the hostel.
- No boarder should visit in any other hostel block/dormitory without specific permission of the hostel superintendent nor should he keep/call any unauthorised person in his dormitory.
- In case of severe illness of a boarder parents are duly informed in time. Parents must come to take the responsibility of the child.
- Despite all its security arrangements and safety measures the hostel management won't be responsible for any accidental mishap.
- Text Books & Stationeries are to be provided by the parents in time. Under certain unavoidable circumstances only, the
  hostel may decide to manage the things. The amount of expenditure would be recovered from the Boarder's Personal
  Fund.
- 10. Expenditure against Excursions or outside school programmes would be charged extra.
- 11. Parents must never force their child to live in the hostel if he himself is not willing to do so. This hampers his emotional development and eventually his intelligence.
- 12. It takes some time to the newly admitted boarder to adapt himself to the new environment. In the beginning he may make many an excuse for leaving the hostel for home. In such a situation, parents should personally meet the Hostel Superintendent / Principal and know the reality and not form unwanted opinions or develop any kind of prejudice.
- 13. Parent's frequent visits unconsciously / subconsciously develop homesickness in the boarding child. This ultimately impedes his academic development, in particular.
- 14. Hostel life inculcates in the child the virtues that are essential for making him self confident, regular, diligent and industrious. We all would let him live a life in which would get of labour has got its own importance.
